





Option 1: In the blue navigation bar, hover over **Partners** and click on **Realtor Training** by Jeff Lobb:




This will take you to a page with Jeff's bio and picture – underneath, you'll click on **Real Estate Agents – Click to Sign in to Your Video Training Library**





3. Either option will take you to the login page – click the **New User** button:




- 4. You will be prompted for a password enter familyfirst (all lowercase)
- 5. You will then see a screen with "All Access" Click Select


